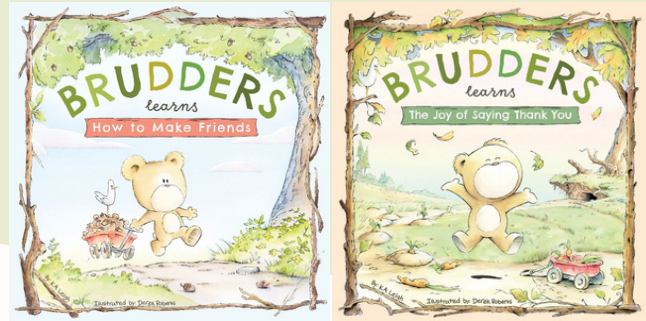
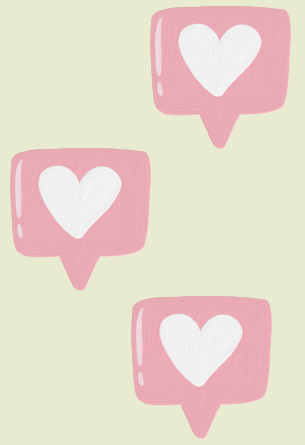

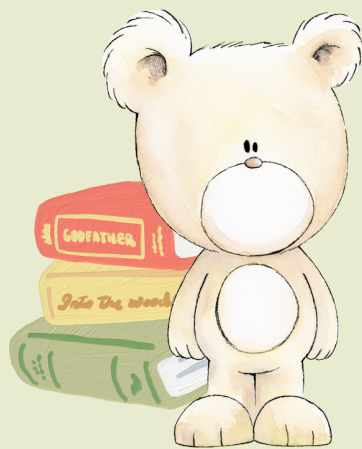
1. Teach Telling vs. Tattling

Ask your child these three questions:

- Are you hurt?
- Are you in danger?
- Are you frustrated?



Tell a grown-up if you feel hurt or in danger.



Tell Brudders what's been frustrating you. He always has one bigger ear...and that's for listening!

2. Host Morning Meeting

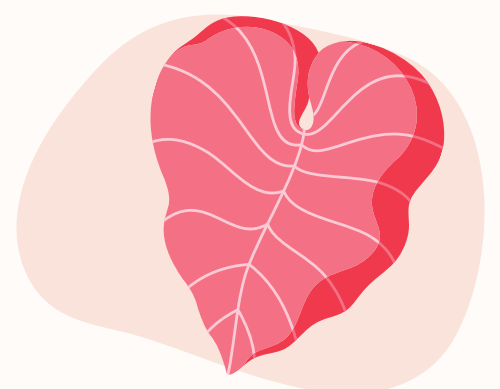
Children thrive in predictable environments. This routine teaches polite behaviors, patience, and listening skills.



1. Sit in a circle and greet one another with their name, a handshake, and eye contact.
2. Take turns sharing something you're happy about.
3. Then, take turns asking questions to others...but make sure to always start your question by using the person's name.
